Dear Mrs. Berry:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 09/15/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the onsite inspection I observed circle time and music time with use of age-appropriate media and educational materials to encourage literacy. I observed both caregivers to be engaged with the children and to tend to their various needs. I observed lunch. I observed the outdoor play area. Records were readily available and organized.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1903 Licensee responsibilities.

(7) The licensee shall cooperate with the department by ensuring that all individuals requiring a comprehensive background check are entered into the child care background check system and processed for eligibility as required by section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, and R 400.1925.

Mrs. Berry's adult son, Trenton, returned to the home following graduation from college. This adult household member was not previously entered into the child care background check system.

(9) Provide identifying information to the department on both of the following individuals

who are associated with the child care license:

(a) Licensee.

(b) Adult household member.
