III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection, I observed lunch time, hand washing, toileting, and nap time. Mrs. Allgood's interactions with the child care children were positive and developmentally appropriate.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1910

Ratio of personnel to children.

(1) The ratio of personnel to children present in the home at any 1 time must be not less than 1 member of the personnel to 6 children. The ratio must include all children in care who are not related to any personnel and any of the following children who are less than 6 years of age:

(a) Children of the licensee.

(b) Children of a child care staff member or child care assistant.

(c) Children related to any member of the household by blood, marriage, or adoption.

Mrs. Allgood was present with 11 unrelated children in the home. Mrs. Allgood is approved for a ratio variance allowing a child care staff member to child ratio of 1:7. She did not meet this ratio requirement.

During the on-site inspection Mrs. Allgood had a supervised volunteer present to assist with the care of the children. I provided technical assistance explaining that her supervised volunteer does not count in ratio.

I provided technical assistance on serving milk with meals per rule 400.1931(1)(a) and topical medications.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this group home (7-14).
