II. Purpose of Addendum

Ms. Weston submitted a request for modification to add an upper-level bedroom to be used for sleeping purposes only as additional child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on October 12th, 2022.

Ms. Christa Weston has been a licensed child care provider since January 7th, 2022. She resides in a two-story house with a basement in a rural area of Deerfield. Ms. Weston has requested to modify the terms of her current license to add one upper-level bedroom to be used for sleeping purposes only as additional child use space. Her new child use space includes:

Main Level: kitchen/dining room, living room, family, and one bedroom that will exclusively be used for sleeping purposes only.

Upper level: One bedroom that will exclusively be used for sleeping purposes only.

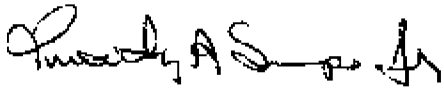
The main and upper-level approved child use space has a sufficient amount of space to accommodate the minimum requirement of 35 sq. ft. per child of use space and also accommodate the licensed capacity of 12 children ages birth to 12 years old. The entire lower level (basement) of the home is not approved for child care use and will only be used for conducting tornado drills or during actual tornado emergencies. Ms. Weston operates Monday through Friday from 7:00 am until 5:00 pm, year-round.

There is a bathroom located on the main level of the home. The home has adequate fire exits. The main level uses two remote door exits located in the front and rear of the house. The upper level also utilizes two exits: one being the steps that provide a direct, safe means of unobstructed travel to the main level and the other being a remote window that is easily accessible, clearly identified, and can be readily opened by caregiving staff and children. The window is of a size and design to allow for evacuation of all children and caregiving staff.

Ms. Weston has completed the required radon testing on 11/24/2021 with a radon test result of 1.3 picocuries per liter of air. She is in compliance with the licensing standards of not more than 4 picocuries per liter of air.

V. Recommendation

I approve the addition of the upper-level bedroom that will be used for sleeping purposes only as approved child use space.
