

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

When I arrived on-site, Ms. Jessica Reeder was present; along with child care staff member Ms. Jennifer Daggett and household member Ms. Mackenzie Reeder. There were seven children in attendance. Ms. Daggett and Ms. Mackenzie Reeder were playing on the floor with the children in the living room. Ms. Jessica Reeder was cleaning up the dining room area and attending to children as needed. Both Ms. Jessica Reeder and Ms. Daggett had a good rapport with one another, as well as, with the child care children. The children appeared to be happy and comfortable within their care and familiar with the routine and expectations.


The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical assistance was provided to Ms. Jessica Reeder in the following areas:

- **R400.1919(3) Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.** Submit a tuberculosis test for the minor household member who will turn 14 on 02/29/2022.
- **R400.1906(g)(i-iii) Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.** Forms were provided to Ms. Reeder to be completed and kept on file for herself and all child care staff members.
- **R400.1923(2)(e) Diapering and toilet learning.** Clarified that cleaned and sanitized means to first wash vigorously with soap and water, rinse with clear water and then sanitize.
- **R400.1916(5) Bedding and sleeping equipment.** The play yard without a manufacturer's date needs to be removed and no longer used by child care children.
- **R400.1931(8) Food preparation and service.** Bottles used for feeding must be labeled with the child's first and last name and date, refrigerated, and served only to the child on the label.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity of 7-12).
