Dear Ms. Adams:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 06/16/2021. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

When I arrived on-site, Ms. Valerie Adams and household member/child care staff member Mr. Paul Adams were present; along with six children in attendance. All of the children were outside playing in the large fenced in play area. They were observed playing on the monkey bars and swings and playing with a tub of garden fairy toys. Ms. Adams stated that the children are inside in the morning for breakfast and they usually watch a little bit of television then and inside in the afternoon for rest time. Otherwise, they spend the rest of the day outside. There is a canopy tent set up in the back yard with picnic tables underneath it for the children to sit at and eat their meals. The outdoor play area is very nicely shaded and completely surrounded by a wooden fence. Ms. Adams and Mr. Adams both had a good rapport with the children, they attended to their wants and needs. The children appeared happy and comfortable within their care.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.

Technical assistance and consultation was provided to Ms. Valerie Adams in the following areas:

- **R400.1905(6) Training.** Completion of the required training must be verified by a document, signed by the trainer or an authorized individual, which must be kept on file or available online at MiRegistry.
- **R400.1923(2)(e) Diapering and toilet learning.** The designated changing area must: Be cleaned and sanitized after each use.
 - “Cleaned” means washed vigorously with soap and water and rinsed with clean water.
- **Referenced the Guidelines for Safe Child Care Operations During COVID-19, available via the department’s website, to assure the facility is following all applicable items.**


