Approved child use space: The daycare room with kitchenette, bedroom 1 (SE), the cubby room (NE) and the family room (adjacent to the daycare room) are approved for child care use. There is a bathroom located in the daycare room that is used by the child care children.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are four exits available on the main level of the home. One door (N) located in the daycare room with the kitchenette exits out to a wooden deck with two steps down to the driveway. One door (N) located in the cubby room exits out to a wooden deck with two steps down to the driveway. One door (S) located in the family room exits directly out to the fenced in outdoor play area. One door (N) located in the family room exits out to a wooden deck with two steps down to the driveway.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

When I arrived on-site, Ms. Brittany Dougherty and child care staff member Mr. Cody Dougherty, Madison Miller and Reaghan Dolphin. were present; along with ten child care children in attendance. All of the children and child care staff members were located in the daycare room engaged in free play, then transitioned to lunch. All caregivers were present in the room interacting and attending to the needs of the children in care.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance was provided to Ms. Dougherty in the following areas:

- Provided guidance on updated child information cards and child in care statements.
- Provided guidance on updating Cody Dougherty CCBS to reflect household and child care staff member.
