

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


During the onsite inspection there were seven child care children, Ms. Carnes and one child care staff member present. The children were in the family room and were participating in singing and counting with the child care staff member. One child was being held and consoled by Ms. Carnes during the visit. All children were appropriately interacted with and supervised.

Technical assistance was provided regarding Ms. Carnes ensuring CCBC is updated timely and updating child in care statements.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
