R400.1919(3)	Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.



Approved child use space: On the main floor of the home the kitchen, living room, laundry room, and two bedrooms are approved for child use space. In the basement of the home the preschool room, the nap room, and the playroom are used for child use space.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): On the main floor of the home a door off the living room leads to the front yard, a door off the dining area leads to a deck in the back yard and a door off the kitchen leads to the garage. In the basement, there are window exits in the preschool room and small playroom.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1905 Training.

- (3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:
 - (a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.

One child care staff member did not have training in safe sleep practices.

R 400.1906 Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.

- (1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child care staff member and each child care assistant that includes all of the following:
 - (c) A statement signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee that attests to the individual's mental and physical health., and which must be updated as follows:
 - (ii) For a child care staff member and a child care assistant, within 1 year prior to caring for children and at the time of subsequent renewals of the child care home's license.

One child care staff member did not have a signed statement from a licensed physician attesting to her mental and physical health and one child care staff member did not have an updated medical clearance form.

R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

One child care staff member did not have documentation that she was free of the communicable disease tuberculosis.

R 400.1925 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(1) Pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, prior to an individual having any unsupervised contact with children, the department shall determine the individual's eligibility to be any of the following:


(d) A child care staff member.

One child care staff member did not have a comprehensive background check.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 06/27/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change in license status.
