Dear Ms. McDaniel:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 03/21/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

When I arrived for my onsite inspection, Ms. McDaniel explained that she was trying to keep one ill child from the rest of the group until their mother was getting there. The ill child was an infant, so she held on to the infant during my visit, while caring for two small infants on the other side of the room. Her child care staff member was caring for the other children and allowing them to free play. The children had just finished up their snack prior to me arriving. The home was free of any hazards and no concerns were noted.

I spoke with Ms. McDaniel about the upcoming refingerprinting for those that had their comprehensive background check five years ago, we discussed the need to evaluate those persons on her CCBC system and whether or not they would fall under the definition of a household member or an unsupervised volunteer anymore. There is one child care assistant that is Ms. McDaniel needed to connect to her CCBC system.

As a reminder PA 116 defines adult house hold member as "Member of the household" means any individual who resides in a family child care home, group child care home, foster family home, or foster family group home on an ongoing basis, or who has a recurrent presence in the home, including, but not limited to, overnight stays. For foster family homes and foster family group homes, a member of the household does not include a foster child. For group child care homes and family child care homes, a member of the household does not include a child to whom child care is being provided."
