The terms of the original license have been modified on 3/6/2023.


Ms. Langlois reached out indicating that she would like to offer over night care for some of her existing children or possibly families in the future.

Completed an onsite inspection at the child care home on 2/21/2023, observed child care staff members caring for children and they were napping. However, I was able to see one toddler bed and a crib.

Ms. Langlois and I discussed the need for a bigger bed if children are over the age of 3 because she just has a toddler bed at this time. Also discussed that she needs to sleep on the same floor as the children and that if the children are not sleeping she cannot sleep.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of overnight care to Ms. Langlois's license.
