A. Description of Facility

This child care facility is located at 500 W. Pine Street in Fremont, Michigan near the intersection of Gerber Ave. and S Lake Drive. This is a single-story home with a finished basement located in a residential area.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use: The basement level of the home is approved for child care use space.

Ages of children served: Children birth through 4-years and 9 months of age are approved for care.

Equipment: There is an adequate amount of equipment for children's use.

Proposed days and hours of operation: This child care facility will operate Monday through Friday from 7:00am until 6:00pm.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: Gillian and Jenna Karnemaat have not been previously licensed for child care or children's foster care services.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): Basement level exits include the walk out slider to the back yard and the stairs leading to the main level.

Outdoor play area description: There is a fenced in play area in the backyard of the home.
