She provided ratio coverage while child care staff member Trenere Walker was on lunch break. | Ms. Wicks-Johnson will ensure that there are always at least two certified staff members at all times. She has hired a third staff member and is working with [REDACTED] to complete the requirements to be a child care staff member. The addition of these two individuals will help the home maintain ratio requirements at all times. | 02/02/2023 |

| R 400.1916 Bedding and sleeping equipment. | On 11/17/2022, A 10-month-old infant slept in a bouncy seat during nap time. The infant was not moved to approved sleeping equipment until I told Ms. Wicks-Johnson the infant could not sleep in a bouncy seat | Ms. Wicks-Johnson will ensure that all children that fall asleep in play equipment are moved to an approved sleeping area. Ms. Wicks-Johnson has provided training to staff regarding licensing rules and safe sleep. Ms. Wicks-Johnson and all staff will re-take safe-sleep for child care providers and inform Michelle Fruehan once it is completed. | 02/02/2023 |
