Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including singing and dancing. I observed group time which included number and letter recall. I also observed diapering, toileting, hand washing, meal preparation and service, and naptime. Ms. Wicks-Johnson and the child care staff member's interactions with the children were positive and nurturing. They were attentive to the children's needs.
