Dear Sister Immaculata,

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 05/10/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(a) Child development.

The licensee said she and her assistant caregiver had not yet completed any of the Health and Safety Course 1 or Course 2 training on MiRegistry.org., including the topic of child development.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(b) Administration of medication.

The licensee said she and her assistant caregiver had not yet completed any of the Health and Safety Course 1 or Course 2 training, including the topic of administering medication.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(c) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.

The licensee said she and her assistant caregiver had not yet completed any of the Health and Safety Course 1 or Course 2 training, including the topic of preventing emergencies related to food and allergic reactions.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants.

The licensee said she and her assistant caregiver had not yet completed any of the Health and Safety Course 1 or Course 2 training, including the topic of Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(f) Building and physical premises safety.

The licensee said she and her assistant caregiver had not yet completed any of the Health and Safety Course 1 or Course 2 training, including the topic of building and physical premises safety.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

The licensee said she and her assistant caregiver had not yet completed any of the Health and Safety Course 1 or Course 2 training, including the topic of hazards, emergency preparedness, and response planning.

(6) Completion of the required training must be verified by a document, signed by the trainer or an authorized individual, which must be kept on file or available online at MiRegistry.

The licensee indicated that her assistant had already completed safe sleep and shaken baby syndrome training, but there was no documentation on file.

R 400.1945 Emergency; plan; drill.

1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home.

The plan must address the following types of emergencies:

(e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, all of the following:

- (i) Intruders.
- (ii) Active shooters.
- (iii) Bomb threats.
- (iv) Other man- or woman-caused events.

There were no crisis management plans to address intruders, active shooters, bomb threats or other person-caused events.

Technical assistance was provided in the following areas:

- Updated child information cards, child in care statements, fire/tornado drill logs, and a licensing notebook summary sheet were provided.
- Sample emergency plans were provided.
- The licensee has one play yard that was not in use. There are no infants in care. We were unable to see the date of manufacture. The licensee will use the brand name (Costco Juvenile) and model number to ensure the crib was manufactured after 2/19/14 prior to using it.
- Links to the MiRegistry Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2 were provided.

On May 10, 2022 you provided an acceptable written corrective action plan.
