During the onsite inspection, I observed the children in care participating in singing songs, coloring paper using crayons, and a short time watching an age-appropriate educational video. The children in care were comfortable in communicating their needs and wants to the child care staff. The child care staff were nurturing and attentive to the needs of the children. I observed the child care staff in proper diapering procedures and assisting children in care with toileting. I watched the children in care perform handwashing after toileting and before being served lunch.

As a result of the renewal inspection on 07/11/2023, I did not find any rule or law violations. You will receive your regular license in the mail.
