Dear Ms. Keller:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department’s findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 07/18/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the onsite inspection, I observed the children in care participating in handwashing, toileting, lunch time and napping. The children in care were comfortable in communicating their needs and wants to the child care staff. The child care staff members were nurturing and attentive in meeting the needs of the children in care.

The violations that were found are:

On 07/18/2023, licensee, Deoundrea Keller, and child care staff member, (T.K.), prior to caring for children, did not complete training that includes information on recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect. On 07/27/2023, licensee	

completed the training and child care staff member, T.K. completed the training on 07/29/2023.

<p>On 07/18/2023, when the department of licensing and regulatory affairs published a notice that a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee, Deoundrea Keller, and child care staff member, (T.K.), did not complete the activity within 6 months of the notice. Deoundrea Keller did not complete refreshers training year 2021 and 2022. Child care staff member (T.K.), did not complete refreshers training year 2020 and 2022. On 07/23/2023, licensee completed the training 2020 and 2021, 07/25/2023 completed training for year 2022. Child care staff member, T.K. completed the training year 2020 and 2022 on 07/30/2023.</p>	

During the exit conference, I provided technical assistance and consultation regarding the following:

- Reviewing child information card to make sure that they are completed with admission date, allergies and special needs are filled in correctly and updated yearly
- Reviewing child in care statements to ensure that they are completely filled out and updated yearly.
- Suggestions to revising the emergency crisis management plans, for example, o adding more details to transporting infants and toddlers; adding addresses of

relocation sites; although not currently having children enrolled, addressing, how children with special needs and medical conditions, will be cared for during implementation of the emergency crisis plans.

On 07/18/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.
