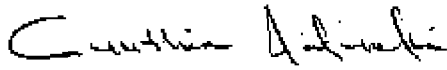

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R400.1905(1) Training.

(1) A licensee shall complete not less than 10 clock hours of training each calendar year related to child development, program planning, and administrative management for a child care business, not including CPR, first aid, and infectious disease, including immunizations, training.

The licensee did not obtain 10 clock hours of training in 2020 and 2021.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

LSR dated: 7/7/2020

R400.1905(2) Training

(2) A child care staff member and a child care assistant shall complete not less than 5 clock hours of training each calendar year related to child development and caring for children, not including CPR, first aid, and infectious disease, including immunizations, training

Staff member T.K. did not obtain 5 clock hours of training in 2020 and 2021.

REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

LSR dated: 7/7/2020

CAP dated: 7/7/2020

R400.1905(4) Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

- (a) Child development.
- (b) Administration of medication

- (c) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.
- (d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants.
- (f) Building and physical premises safety.
- (g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

The licensee and staff member T.K. did not complete training included in R 400.1904(4).

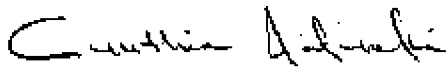
Consultation and technical assistance were provided in the following areas:

- Suggested minor revisions to emergency/crisis management plans.
- Provided updated forms for children's records to be updated annually.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 06/16/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewing the license for two years.
