Before and after lunch time, child care staff wiped the children's hands with	Licensee Jenny Dillon states that during hand washing, the child care staff will use the sink to access running water and soap, with the children that can walk and not use wipes.	4/17/2023

	disposable wipes. Children had access to soap and running water from the nearby bathroom sink.		
<b>R 400.1924(2)(b) Hand washing.</b>	I observed, as children transitioned for nap time, that children were not washing their hands after diapering. Child care staff did not ensure that the diapered children, participated in hand washing after diapering.	Licensee Jenny Dillon states that child care staff will ensure handwashing is done by the children, using the sink every day and whenever toileting or diapering is completed.	4/17/2023

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
