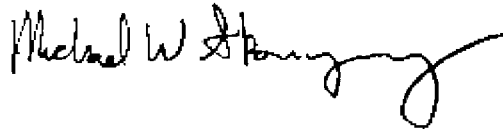

Approved child use space: The entire main floor is approved for childcare use. The upper bedrooms are approved for resting/naps only.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three exits on the main level of the home. The first exit is the front door off of the living room which provides egress to the front yard. The second exit is the back door off of the family room which provides egress to the back yard. The third exit is the garage door which provides egress to the side yard of the home. The second level has two exits. The first exit is the emergency window in one of the bedrooms. The second exit is the stairs which provides egress to the main level of the home.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

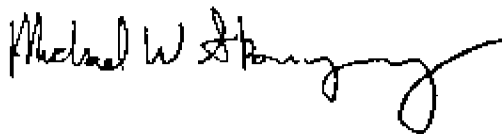
The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical Assistance was offered in the following areas:

- A new rescue ring/flotation device was recommended for the pool area
- It is recommended that the child in care statements be updated to the newest form available.
- Provider was asked to ensure that she and her husband (assistant caregiver) to ensure all their required trainings are completed and to ask their consultant if there is ever any confusion or questions in this area

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
