

Approved child use space: Main floor: kitchen, living room and dining room. There is a bathroom available for children's use located off the living room.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level of the home has four remote exits; the front door, two side doors and a garage door which each lead to outside and are labeled as exits. The upper level of the home has two remote exits; a window and stairs leading down to the main level. The basement level of the home has two remote exits; stairs leading up and a window. The basement and upper level are not approved for child care use. The basement may be used as a storm shelter.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection I observed Lavinia Carey and Edson Carey providing direct supervision of the children during free play activities upon my arrival. The children were observed playing with age-appropriate toys. I observed hand washing and snack time. I observed both caregivers nurturing and feeding the infant child present. The children appeared to be happy and well bonded to both caregivers. The home was clean and safe for child care use. Required records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
