

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


During the on-site inspection, I observed licensee provide direct supervision and assistant caregiver to children during naptime, transition from naptime, free play activities, bathroom and handwashing. Licensee and assistant caregiver's interactions with the children were nurturing, positive and developmentally appropriate. The home was clean and safe for child care use. Required records were organized and readily available for review.
