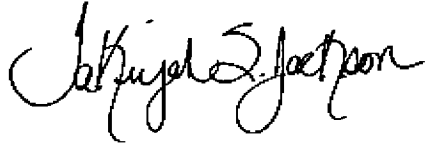

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

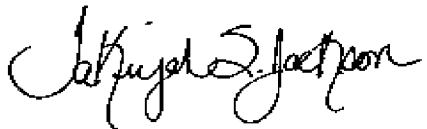
This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection, I observed the licensee and assistant care giver provide direct supervision to children in care during, educational television programming, free play activities, tummy time, snack time, and handwashing. Ms. Walton and her assistant caregiver's interaction with children in care was positive, nurturing and age appropriate. The home was clean and safe for children in care. Records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
