One child care staff member only completed two clock hours of training. The other child care staff member did not complete any clock hours of training. R 400.1905(3)(a) Training.	One child care staff member did not have training in safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome prior to caring for children.	The licensee stated that the child care staff member would obtain safe sleep training.	06/17/2023
R 400.1905(9) Training.	One child care staff member did not complete the 2022 health and safety training activity that was published in MI Registry within six months of the notice.	The licensee stated that the child care staff member would complete the 2022 refresher training in Mi Registry.	06/17/2022
R 400.1919(1) Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.	The licensee did not obtain a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or designee, that attests to the applicant's mental and physical health, at the time of renewal.	The licensee stated that she would obtain a medical clearance for herself and submit it to the department.	07/06/2023
R 400.1919(2) Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.	Two child care staff members did not have a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or designee, that attests to the child care staff member's mental and physical health, at the time of renewal.	The licensee stated that she would obtain updated medical clearances for both of her child care staff members and submit them to the department.	07/06/2023
R 400.1920(1) Outdoor play area and equipment.	The child care home did not have a clean, safe, and hazard free outdoor play area. There was a rusty wheelbarrow, a lawn mower, and a dune buggy within the child use area outdoors.	The licensee stated that she would move the lawn mower, dune buggy, and the wheelbarrow out of the child use area.	06/17/2023
R 400.1932(2) Home maintenance and safety.	Dangerous and hazardous materials were stored within reach of children.	The licensee stated that she would remove the unsafe items.	06/17/2023

	<p>There were loose pellets/beads stored in a kitchen drawer with a broken latch. There was a second kitchen drawer that contained saran wraps with serrated edges that had a broken latch. The bathroom cabinet under the sink had a broken lock allowing children to access witch hazel, lice treatment, and cords to hair appliances that presented a strangulation hazard.</p>
