Approved child use space: The playroom, art room, and bathroom on the upper level of the home is approved for care. The playroom and bathroom on the lower level of the home are approved for use. The licensee has requested to add the kitchen and dining area on the upper level of the home and a bedroom/living area on the lower level of the home.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level of the home has three standard door exits properly terminated to grade. There is a front door, a side garage exit, and a back door that exits off the unapproved living room. On the lower level of the home there are stairs leading the main level of the home, and a back stairway leading to an exit in the fenced play area.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1905                      Training.**

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(a) Safe sleep practices to prevent sudden infant death syndrome.

One child care staff member did not have training that included safe sleep practices and SIDS prior to caring for children. She thought it was included as part of MiRegistry Parts 1&2.

**R 400.1919                      Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.**

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

One child care staff member did not provide written evidence of freedom from TB prior to caring for children.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/01/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
