Dear Ms. Jones:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 02/16/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

**R 400.1916                      Bedding and sleeping equipment.**

(12) Children 12 to 24 months of age shall rest or sleep alone in an approved crib, portacrib, play yard, or on a cot or mat sufficient for the child's length, size, and movement.

At the time of the inspection, I observed a baby who was over 12 months sleeping in a swing. Ms. Jones indicated that he is used to his swing at home and he sleeps better in it. She also was not aware that a baby over 12 months could not sleep in this equipment (only babies 12 months and under). I reminded her of the rule and she agreed to comply with this immediately. She also agreed that her assistant and her would retake the safe sleep course.

**R 400.1931                      Food preparation and service.**

(8) Bottles used for feeding must be labeled with the child's first and last name and date, refrigerated, and served only to the child on the label.

At the time of the inspection there was a baby bottle in the refrigerator without a label. Ms. Jones indicated that there is only one baby on bottles so she didn't think she had to label it just for that child. I clarified that the rule must still be followed unless even if one child attends who takes a bottle.

**R 400.1933**

**Water supply; sewage disposal; water temperature.**

(4) Hot water temperature must not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit at water faucets accessible to children.

At the time of the inspection the water tested 130 degrees Fahrenheit. Ms. Jones stated that she would ensure that the water would be turned down to 120 degrees or below.

Violations were identified at the time of the inspection. You have provided an acceptable written corrective action plan.

- Completely filling out the child in care statement forms for both parents and licensee


