Approved child use space: Child care children enter the home at a side entrance near the garage. At ground level there is a mud room (foyer), playroom and office. On the main level of the home are two bathrooms, dining room, living room and two bedrooms for napping purposes only.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The ground level of the home has three remote exits. One exit to the front of the garage, one exit to the back yard of the home and one exit into the garage of the home. The main level of the home has two remote exits, one exit to the front yard of the home and one exit to the lower level of the home which is at ground level. There is a staircase between the lower level and main level of the home. Ms. Dymond is aware that a child gate must be used to prevent children from accessing the staircase unsupervised
