Dear Ms. Nimer:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 02/17/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Licensee Khetam Nimer and her two child care staff members Noor Ghali and Amani Nimer failed to complete the required MiRegistry health and safety training in 2022.

R 400.1907

Child's records.

(2) Records in subrule (1) of this rule must be reviewed and updated annually or when information changes.

Licensee Khetam Nimer did not ensure that all 10 of the child information cards and child in care statements were reviewed and updated annually.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by March 15, 2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
