

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:


- R 400.1925 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.**
- (2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:**
(b) Maintain a copy of the completed and signed form(s) for each individual entered into the child care background check system under the license.

On 08/06/2022, Ms. Darrell did not have a copy of the completed and signed consent and disclosure from for herself, staff members and adult household member.

Technical assistance was provided regarding updating emergency plans to include a relocation site, contacting parents and plans for accommodating infants, toddlers and children with special needs. Technical assistant was also provided regarding making sure the date of admission was written on all child information cards.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 09/06/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
