III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and

training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1904a Child care staff member; employment requirements.

(3) Prior to contact with children, the individual shall be determined by the department to be eligible to serve as a child care staff member, pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, and as required by R 400.1925.

On 10/31/2022 the licensee's child care staff member has not been fingerprinted.

R 400.1925 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(1) Pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, prior to an individual having any unsupervised contact with children, the department shall determine the individual's eligibility to be any of the following:
(b) An adult member of the household
(d) A child care staff member.

On 10/31/2022 the licensee's adult household member who is also a child care staff member had not been fingerprinted.

On 10/31/2022 during an onsite inspection, the children were engaged in some Halloween activities including painting pumpkins, dressing up in costumes, dancing to Halloween music, playing musical chairs and listening to a Halloween story. All staff members interacted appropriately with all children present.


Technical assistant was provided regarding updating their emergency plans to include a sentence on how infants and toddlers would be accommodated during each type of emergency as well as clearly labeling their crisis management plans for active shooters.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 10/31/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify

compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
