## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.


Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection, children were observed to be engaged in age-appropriate activities. Children participated in activities that build gross motor skills. Staff were observed properly supervising children during all activities and using proper transitional techniques when moving from one area to the next. Positive caregiver and child interactions was also observed.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
