

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts. Ms. Baker provides a nurturing and safe environment for her children in care. She creates learning opportunities in all daily activities. During the onsite inspection, the children were drawing self-portraits. The children will make another self-portrait in June. An assessment of growth will be done to compare the two drawings. Ms. Baker and her assistant, Ms. Keisha keeps portfolios on each child. During the school year, they build on the portfolios through many fun, engaging, and learning activities.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
