III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection, children were observed engaging in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities. They engaged in sensory activities, and pretend play. The facility is equipped with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. The child care staff members and child interactions were very nurturing and positive. Children were also observing having snack.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
