R 400.1916(8) Bedding and sleeping equipment.	Ms. Mitchell placed a child in a snowsuit, then placed the child inside of the pack and play to sleep.	Nothing is placed in the crib or pack and play nor has it even been. The snowsuit will no longer be used as a wearable blanket.	3/1/2022
R 400.1915(2) Indoor space; play equipment and materials.	A child was resting in a bedroom not approved for child use by the department.	Denise Mitchell and Rachel Mitchell have registered for safe sleep training for providers offered through MiRegistry. Ms. Mitchell has completed cribs for kids safe sleep training.	3/1/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
