

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,


and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection there were five children enrolled and two children who were Ms. Anderson's. The children have a very engaging program. They sang songs through all of their learning. They sang good morning, the alphabet, their shapes, and the days of the week. They identified their feelings and body parts through a chart that was on the wall. They read a book that rhymed, and the children were able to verbally follow along. Technical Assistance was provided to Ms. Anderson regarding the upkeep of her staff and children's files, and the requirements of the licensing notebook. Ms. Anderson served cereal and milk for breakfast and chicken nuggets, tator tots, strawberries, and milk for lunch.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 06/30/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
