III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

When I arrived for the inspection, Ms. Cook and one child care staff member were outside with 12 child care children during outdoor play. The children transitioned inside and watched television for a short period of time while Ms. Cook and the child care staff member prepared lunch. I observed sanitation and handwashing prior to the children eating lunch. Ms. Cook and her child care staff member engaged in positive interactions with the children and tended to the children's needs appropriately.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
