**Comments**

An Administrative Review was conducted on October 20, 2021. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A Virtual Visit Initial Licensing Study was conducted on October 20, 2021. The exit conference was conducted virtually on October 20, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. with the Director. The Final License will be issued upon completion of the Exit Conference and signature pages are returned to the consultant. Facility does carry Liability Insurance. The overall capacity is limited to 138 children due to the playground capacity.

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is **valid for thirty(30) days**. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the fence on playground A had rust and chipped paint throughout the wrought iron bars, accessible to the children.
