If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.03(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined that on August 14, 2017, at 5:55 p.m., a two-year-old child sustained Nursemaid's Elbow, to the right arm, when a staff person held both of the child's hands and pulled the child up off the floor and when the child stumbled the staff person released the child's hands causing the child to fall to the floor. The child placed one hand on the floor to catch his fall. Professional medical attention was obtained.
