Advisement of Potential for Repeated Rule Violations during Pending Investigations

During this investigation period, any violations of an identical rule or rules will require the department to treat any and all substantiated rule violations identified in the investigation as repeated rule violation(s).

Further, from time to time the department discovers additional rule violations during the course of an investigation. If there are new rule violation(s), your consultant shall inform you of the violation(s) as soon as possible. However, as stated above, any violations of identical rule(s) will require the department to treat any and all additional rule violations identified in the investigation as repeated rule violations.

All rule violations found in relation to a complaint or incident investigation will be associated with the date the investigation was closed.



Please refer to the website, <http://www.decal.ga.gov/CCS/RulesAndRegulations.aspx>, for information regarding October 1, 2018 rule changes about Criminal Records Checks that may affect your facility. In summary,

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.08 Children's Records

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.08(2) requires Center Staff to maintain a file for each child that includes evidence of age-appropriate immunizations or a signed affidavit against such immunizations for each child enrolled in the center on a form approved by the Department, and to allow no child to continue enrollment in the Center for more than thirty (30) days without such evidence. It was determined that as of this date, March 29, 2023, a three-year-child did not have evidence of up-to-date immunizations records in their file. Investigative findings revealed that based upon a review of records, the child did not have evidence of an up-to-date immunization record on their file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will have and use a plan to track immunization forms for all enrolled children and to ensure the form or affidavit are obtained from the parent or guardian within 30 days of enrollment. Parents will be informed their child cannot remain enrolled in the center without this documentation.

Health and Hygiene

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-17(7) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids and after contamination by any other means. It was determined based on investigative findings that on March 17, 2023, children in the Pre-K classroom were not washing their hands as required due to them not having access to warm running water due to the water brown in color. Investigative findings further revealed that on March 17, 2023, the water was discolored and the children in the Georgia Pre-K class were using hand sanitizer in place of hand washing. Investigative findings further revealed that there was no warm running water, as the hot water had been turned off under the sink for repairs.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff on required handwashing for children and Staff will ensure children's hands are washed when required. The Director will monitor for compliance.

Correction Deadline: 3/31/2023**Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.17(8) requires staff to wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for the day, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after diapering each child, dispensing medication, applying topical medications, handling and preparing food, eating, drinking, preparing bottles, feeding each child, assisting children with eating and drinking, after toileting or assisting children with toileting, using tobacco products, handling garbage and organic waste, touching animals or pets, handling bodily fluids and after contamination by any means. It was determined based on investigative findings that on March 17, 2023, the staff in the Georgia Pre-K classroom were using hand sanitizer in place of hand washing. Investigative findings further revealed that there was no warm running water, as the hot water had been turned off under the sink for repairs.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure liquid soap and warm running water are available for handwashing, train Staff on the handwashing requirements, review the requirements with Staff periodically, and monitor handwashing.

Policies and Procedures

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.21(4) requires the Center to provide to Parents a copy of the Center's written policies and procedures. It was determined based on investigative findings that on March 13, 2023, a copy of the policies and procedures handbook was not provided at the time of enrollment. Investigative findings revealed that when the parent enrolled their child at the center on December 29, 2022, the center failed to provide the parent with a copy of the center's policies and procedures parent's handbook.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will make giving parents a copy of the policies and procedures a routine step in the enrollment process and will train Staff who participate in the enrollment process. The Center will ensure sufficient copies are available.

Correction Deadline: 4/21/2023

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.22 requires the Center to permit the custodial Parent(s) of the child access to all child care areas of the Center at any time the child is in attendance. The custodial Parent(s) shall make his or her presence known to Center Staff prior to removing the child from the Center. It was determined based on investigative findings that on March 13, 2023, a parent was not allowed access into the building where their child was enrolled and present. Investigative findings revealed that there was a disagreement between the parent and the center owner, which led to the parent being informed that the child could remain enrolled but that the parent was not allowed on the grounds or premises of the center.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will permit unlimited parental access.

Correction Deadline: 3/31/2023
