- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
New clearance is required at least once every five years
Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding

EX-HS-.C(1) requires the Program to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled. In order for the file to be complete, the file shall contain the following: child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone numbers, relationship to child and to Parent(s), and other identifying information; name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on a review of submitted documents, that the children's enrollment form does not contain all of the required data.

The program is using a playground behind the building for outdoor play that was not completely fenced in when a gate was not present. The program will use cones or some other barrier as a visual for children when outside. Staff will maintain a watchful oversight of all children.

Finding

EX-HS-.M(2) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that there was no resilient material in the fall zone of the slide.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Program will ensure that there is an adequate amount of resilient material in the fall zones to provide cushioning in case of a fall. The playground will be monitored regularly for maintenance.
