(1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:

(n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in Section 3(1)(e)6 of this administrative regulation;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a staff person (date of hire: 5/30/2014) acting as a caregiver of children in care was left alone with children prior to the licensee receiving the results of the criminal records check and the child abuse or neglect check.

(5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:

(a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;

(b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:

1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and

(c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a staff person (date of hire: 5/30/2014) was working alone with children in the preschool-aged classroom at approximately 11:35 a.m. on the date of the inspection visit without a completed criminal records check and a completed child abuse or neglect check. The staff person's file was reviewed and the results of these background checks were not contained within the file. Based on interview with the staff person in charge, the criminal records check and child abuse or neglect check have been requested but the results have not been received.

320 - TB Verification

(1) Child-care center staff:

(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the files presented for three (3) child-care employees (dates of hire: 2/28/2014, 3/10/2014 and 5/30/2014) did not contain statements from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis or a copy of negative tuberculin results.

325 - CPR/First Aid Coverage

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

(3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.

(4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

Findings:

Based on review of documentation, a staff person (date of hire: 2/28/2014) has been the only person on duty and present with children and is not currently certified in infant and child first aid.

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;**
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and**
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.**

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the file presented and the ECE-TRIS training record for an employee (date of hire: 2/28/2014) did not contain documentation that the employee had completed six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment.
