1 staff for 5 children 10

Toddler

1 staff for 6 children 12

Preschool-age 2 to 3 years

1 staff for 10 children 20

Preschool-age 3 to 4 years

1 staff for 12 children 24

Preschool-age 4 to 5 years

1 staff for 14 children 28

School-age 5 to 7 years

1 staff for 15 children 30

School-age 7 and older

1 staff for 25 children

(for before and after school) 30

1 staff for 20 children

(full day of care) 30

*Maximum Group Size shall be applicable only to Type I child-care centers.

Findings:

General: Based on Interview, it was found through interview with staff that the two (2) year old classroom and the two (2) to three (3) year old classroom are over ratio in the mornings on a regular basis. In an interview with staff, they stated that this occurs daily and that it can sometimes take up to thirty (30) minutes before another staff person is placed in the classroom to help with ratios. Staff stated that they have lost a few staff members and this has helped to create some of the ratio issues. In an interview with the staff in charge, she stated that she had hired extra staff and that hopefully this will help with any ratio issues.
