Findings: General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that the playground had sheep droppings on the ground in multiple areas where children play; therefore, the childcare center director did not provide for the health, safety, and comfort of the children. During interview, the director stated that efforts have been made to fortify the fencing around the playground; however, due to weather conditions, the fencing is not stable. The director stated that children will not use this playground until the fence is repaired.

750 - Playground Conditions	Not In Compliance
922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements. (20) An outdoor play area shall be: (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard; (e) Well drained; (f) Well maintained; (g) In good repair; and (h) Visible to staff at all times.	
Findings: General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that the playground had sheep droppings on the ground in multiple areas; therefore, the outdoor play area was not safe from foreseeable hazards. During interview, the director stated that efforts have been made to fortify the fencing around the playground; however, due to weather conditions, the fencing is not stable. The director stated that a fencing company has been called to repair the existing fence and the children will not use this playground until it is repaired.
