<p>922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements. (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.</p>	
Findings:	
General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a caregiver hired 11/21/16, and a caregiver hired 08/10/16, did not complete orientation training. A caregiver hired 06/10/16, completed six (6) hours of training within her first year of employment and did not complete pediatric abusive head trauma training. A caregiver hired 01/30/06, completed six (6) hours of annual training.

460 - Inaccessible Items

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (7) Except in accordance with subsection (8) of this section, the following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
 - (b) Knives and sharp objects;
 - (c) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids;
 - (d) Plastic bags;
 - (e) Litter and rubbish;
 - (f) Bar soap; and
 - (g) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, two (2) bottles of glass cleaner, a can of carpet cleaner and a can of disinfectant spray were on a shelf accessible to the school-aged children. The bottles and cans were labeled "Keep out of reach of children".

555 - Indoor Gross Motor Space Requirements

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (22) If a child-care center does not have access to an outdoor play area, an indoor space shall:
- (a) Be used as a play area;
 - (b) Have a minimum of sixty (60) square feet per child, separate from and in addition to the thirty-five (35) square feet minimum pursuant to subsection (6) of this section;
 - (c) Include equipment for gross motor skills;
 - (d) Be well-ventilated;
 - (e) Be heated; and
 - (f) Have a protective surface of at least two (2) inches thick around equipment intended for climbing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a three (3) step wooden climber/slide was directly on the floor and did not have a two inch protective surface underneath in the toddlers' room.

595 - Child Personal Care/Handwashing

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (4) A child shall:
- (a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon their developmental skills; and
 - (b) Wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:
 - 1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or
 - b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;
 - 2. Before and after eating or handling food;
 - 3. After toileting or diaper change;
 - 4. After handling animals;
 - 5. After wiping or blowing nose;
 - 6. After touching items soiled with body fluids or wastes; and
 - 7. After outdoor or indoor play time.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, two (2) preschool children did not wash their hands when they arrived. One (1) preschool child did not wash her hands after breakfast. Two (2) school-aged children did not wash their hands after they ate breakfast.

625 - Diaper Changing Area/Surface

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (10) When a child is diapered, the child shall:
- (b) Be placed on a surface that is:
 - 1. Clean;
 - 2. Padded;
 - 3. Free of holes, rips, tears, or other damage;
 - 4. Nonabsorbent;
 - 5. Easily cleaned; and
 - 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the toddlers' caregiver changed a toddler child on a hard surface. The changing table was not padded in the toddlers' room. The diaper changing mat was torn in two (2) places in the two-year-olds' room.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(21) A protective surface shall:

(a) Be provided for outdoor play equipment used to:

- 1. Climb;**
- 2. Swing; and**
- 3. Slide; and**

(b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a toddler slide did not have protective surfacing on the outdoor playground. The climber was about six (6) inches from the fence on the outdoor playground.

General: Based on review of documentation, a child enrolled 04/27/17, had an immunization certificate valid until 05/31/17.

General: Based on interview, the updated written evacuation plan was not provided to the local emergency management official when the plan was updated.
