922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General. (7) If a director, employee, volunteer, or any person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with a child in care is named as the alleged perpetrator in a child abuse or neglect report accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330, the individual shall be removed from direct contact with a child in care: (a) For the duration of the assessment or investigation; and (b) Pending completion of the administrative appeal process for a cabinet substantiation of child abuse or neglect in accordance with 922 KAR 1:320 or 922 KAR 1:480. Findings: General: Based on observation, review of documentation and interview, a caregiver hired 01/23/12, was named as an alleged perpetrator in a child abuse/neglect case accepted by the cabinet. The caregiver continued to have direct contact with a child in care and the surveyor observed the caregiver supervised three (3) children in the infants' room on 04/03/18. Interviews determined the caregiver supervised the toddler children the week of 03/26/18 - 03/30/18, and the infants on 04/02/18. The center was made aware the caregiver was named as an alleged perpetrator on 03/23/18.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities. (1) A director shall: (l) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child; Findings: General: Based on observation, a caregiver hired 01/23/12, placed an infant child (date of birth: 01/12/18), in a swing with a blanket on the side of the infant's face and under the infant's chin to keep a pacifier in place. The blanket touched the bottom of infant's pacifier but was not tight on 03/23/18. The blanket was thick and about 2 feet wide and 2 feet long. A second infant (four (4) weeks old) was observed asleep in a swing with a large blanket on the side of the infant's face and under the infant's chin on 04/03/18.

General: Based on interview, a four (4) week old infant slept in a swing with a blanket around the side of the child's face and under the child's chin on 04/03/18. Interview determined there was no written waiver, from the infant's health professional, for an alternative sleep position.
