922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

(4) A child shall:

- (a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon his or her developmental skills;**
- (b) Except as established in paragraph (c) of this subsection, wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:**

- 1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or**
- b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;**
- 2. Before and after eating or handling food;**
- 3. After toileting or diaper change;**
- 4. After handling animals;**
- 5. After touching an item or an area of the body soiled with body fluids or wastes; and**
- 6. After outdoor or indoor play time; and**

(c) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection. The child shall wash the child's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a child in the Dolphins classroom used the restroom and did not wash their hands; the child then sat at a table and began eating his snack.

(3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:

(b) For a toddler or preschool-age child:

- 1. An individual bed, a two (2) inch thick waterproof mat, or cot in good repair; and**
- 2. Bedding that is in good repair and is changed:**
 - a. Weekly; or**
 - b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation, 16 mats inspected in the Sunfish classroom were frayed and torn in the corners.

815 - Toys/Furniture

General: Based on observation, there were two vinyl chairs in the Tugboats classroom that had tears in the vinyl.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(c) Daily attendance records documenting the arrival and departure time of each child, including records that are required in accordance with 922 KAR 2:160, Section 13, if a child receives services from the child-care center through the Child Care Assistance Program;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, only two of four children were signed into the Minnows classrooms.

1175 - Earthquake/Tornado/Fire Drills

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(h) A written record of quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado drills detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

(i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the Earthquake and Tornado drills were listed as occurring at the same time; these drills require separate actions, and therefore should be documented separately.

(6) In addition to the posting requirement of KRS 199.898(3), a child-care center shall post the following in a conspicuous place and make available for public inspection:

- (a) The provider's preliminary or regular license;**
- (b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year;**
- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;**
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;**
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:**
 - 1. Current rates for child care; and**
 - 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;**
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and**
- (g) Daily planned program.**

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the statement of deficiency and corresponding plan of correction available for public inspection was dated for 2017; the most current inspection report and plan of correction was not available for public review.

1220 - Diapering/Handwashing

(9) The proper methods of diapering and hand-washing shall be posted at each diaper changing area.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the handwashing steps were not posted at the diaper changing area in the Tugboats classroom.
