(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed documentation of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for four (4) staff members hired 12/5/16, 6/1/08, 3/9/20 and 4/19/19.

Review of children's files on 7/1/22 revealed the written record for one (1) child with enrollment date of 3/18/22 failed to contain contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's preferred hospital.
