Findings: General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the bathroom adjacent to the Moving Monkey room, revealed paint peeling off in large pieces over the sink and the caulking surrounding the sink has separated from the wall. The sink is at child's height; therefore, the wall peeling is accessible to children while washing their hands.
