(6) In addition to the posting requirement of KRS 199.898(3), a child-care center shall post the following in a conspicuous place and make available for public inspection: (a) The provider's preliminary or regular license; (b) Each statement of deficiency and civil penalty notice issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year; (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year; (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Website as specified in KRS 199.897; (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including: 1. Current rates for child care; and 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care; (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and (g) Daily planned program. Findings: General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, each Statement of Deficiency issued to the provider by the cabinet for the current licensure year, and the Plan of Corrections submitted to the Cabinet by the provider for the current licensure year failed to be posted in a conspicuous place and made available for public inspection. Interview with the staff in charge revealed the documents were not available at the time of the investigation.
