Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the following was found: 1. One (1) staff person with hire date 7/7/17 had a criminal records check (CRC) dated 7/14/17. 2. One (1) staff person with hire date 8/1/17 had a CRC dated 8/17/17. 3. One (1) staff person with hire date 11/6/17 had a CRC dated 11/9/17. The staff person in charge was not able to produce documentation to verify that the CRC's were submitted within the regulatory timeframe.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Two (2) staff did not have evidence of a negative TB skin test or physician's statement documenting he/she was free from tuberculosis prior to employment. One (1) staff person was hired on 7/7/17; however, did not have a TB skin test until 7/10/17. The second staff person was hired on 8/1/17; however, did not have a TB skin test until 8/9/17.
