General: Based on Interview, it was confirmed that a director of one (1) licensed daycare facility was working part time at another licensed daycare facility. This was also confirmed by reviewing time cards from 09/01/15-02/08/16 for this director at the second facility. Both centers operate during the same hours.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the menu on the day of the investigation stated that pizza, corn and pears were to be served for lunch. The children were served pizza, chips and milk. The menu had not been amended to show this change. The owner stated that the facility refrigerator stopped working yesterday and she had to replace it. She stated that she must have forgotten to serve the other components of lunch to the children.

General: Based on Observation, the children at the facility were served pizza, chips and milk for lunch. There were no fruits or vegetables served to the children. There were fruits and vegetables in the kitchen but the owner stated that she just forgot to give them to the children.
